Updates - TAEH

- Emergency Housing Program
 - TAEH working with Housing Secretariat to determine our role
 - Will engage the TMHASH Network too, and communicate directly with supportive housing providers soon

- Increased role in community-wide data strategy
- Advocacy with Province (2021 Budget) and Federal Gov't (operational funding)

Updates - TAEH

- Plan to End Homelessness
 - Community convened advice to all orders of government
 - SSHA 5-year service plan - our contribution as the non-Indigenous CAB
 - Our opportunity to develop together shared definitions, outcomes, and targets/metrics in ending homelessness
 - Will link to data work
- Increased support/role for PWLE Caucus
- Intentional work to engage Black communities and other communities of colour that are not yet active with the TAEH
- CAB to CAB relationship with the Toronto Indigenous CAB
