Ontario Election - June 2

Vote 4 Housing Ontario

1. Build and acquire 99,000 deeply affordable non-profit, co-op, and supportive homes in the next 10 years.
2. Reinvest in existing community housing by supporting needed repairs and renewal, and ongoing funding for rental assistance.
3. Implement an urban, rural, and northern Indigenous housing strategy for Ontario with dedicated investments through an Indigenous-led approach.
4. Commit to creating a strategy to end chronic homelessness, with clear and measurable targets and timelines, and matching investments.
5. Pledge to make renting a secure and viable option for Ontarians



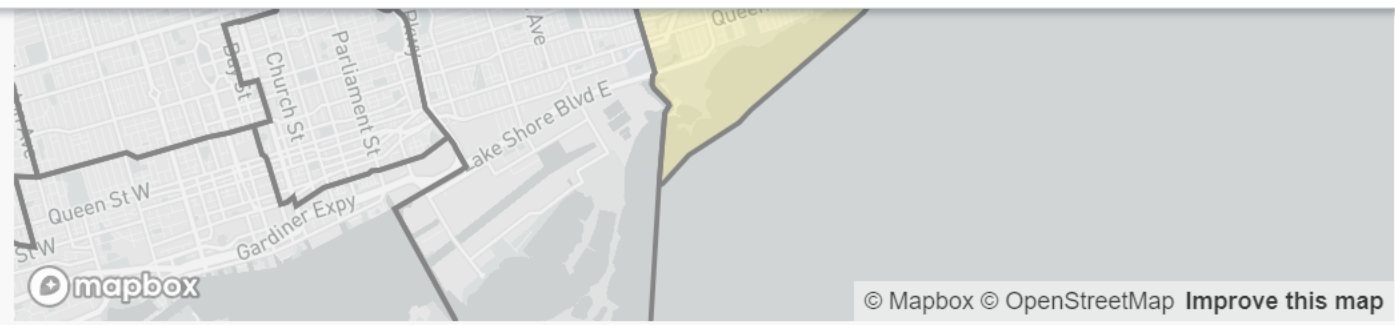
